Privacy policy Invicta Sports

In this privacy statement, we explain what personal data is collected and for what purposes it is used.

Data Collection and Processing

When using our online services, you register certain information with us, which may include personal data. You can provide us with personal data both actively and passively. Active data provision refers to data that you enter yourself or, for example, send to us by e-mail. In addition, data can be stored automatically, sometimes without you being aware of it. In that case, the data is passively provided. In this privacy policy, you will find out exactly which actively and passively provided data is processed and for what purposes. All unnecessary data will be deleted. You can also request access to, modification of, or deletion of data yourself via the contact form on our website. To prevent abuse and/or fraud, we may ask you to identify yourself when you make such a request.

Email

If you fill out a contact or registration form on our website, or send us an e-mail, the data you send us will be kept for as long as the nature of the form or the content of your e-mail requires for complete processing.

Disclosure to third parties

We never provide your data to third parties, unless this is necessary in the context of an agreement you enter into with us or when this is required by law. In the event of suspected fraud or misuse of our website, we may pass on personal data to the competent authorities.

Customer

We store personal data that is necessary for the processing of your request. This includes your name, telephone number, address and date of birth. Your address details are linked to the specific communication. On simple request via e-mail, you can view your data or have it deleted: please use the contact form on our website.

Services from Google, Bing and other websites

On our website, we use certain services from Google, among others, which may require the use of cookies and other techniques - such as Google Analytics, Google AdWords and Webador - to keep track of how users use the website. The information obtained, including the address of your computer (IP address), will be transmitted to Google and Webador and stored by them. They use this information to track how the website is used, to provide us with reports about the website, and to provide advertisers with information about the effectiveness of their campaigns. Google and Webador may provide this information to third parties if Google or Webgo are required to do

so by law, or to the extent that these third parties process the information on behalf of Google and Webador. We have no influence on this.

Click behaviour and visit data

We may maintain general visitor information about our online services. In this context, the IP address of your computer, a user name, the time of retrieval and the data transmitted by a visitor's browser may be recorded in particular and used for statistical analyses of visitor and click behaviour. We try to keep this data as anonymous as possible. This data will not be provided to third parties.

Use of cookies

Invicta Sports uses cookies to make your browsing experience easier and more pleasant and to better tailor the content of the websites to your needs and preferences. You can suppress the installation of cookies, but then some parts of our websites will not work or will not work optimally. If you continue to visit our websites without adjusting your cookie settings or clicking on the "Agree" link, we will assume that you accept the installation of cookies. Please refer to our cookie policy in the paragraphs below for more information on the use of cookies and the possibility to block cookies at any time.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of information that the website sends to your browser so that your browser can be recognized ("session cookie"). Cookies also ensure that visitors to the website can be identified on repeat visits to the website ("persistent cookie"). The cookies are written to the visitor's hard drive. Cookies may be set by the server of the website you are visiting or by partners with whom this website cooperates. Cookies only read the information set by the cookies themselves. The cookies do not have access to any other information. A cookie usually contains the name of the server that placed the cookie, an expiration date, and a unique number code. Cookies help to better tailor the website to the wishes and preferences of visitors. Cookies can also be used to personalize the content of a website or the advertisements on a website for visitors.

Necessary cookies

Third-party cookies
